InDorse Technologies opens UK operations

May 22, 2009 (TELECOMWORLDWIRE via COMTEX) -- InDorse Technologies, a provider of solutions to ensure the integrity and security of business-critical information, announced on Thursday (21 May) the opening of its UK operations and appointed Peter Meehan as the vice president of operations.

According to the company, under the direction of Meehan, the new UK division has established notable market penetration, attracting Microsoft Gold SharePoint partner ICS Solutions with its InDorse SPIDR solution for SharePoint manageability and information protection.

InDorse SPIDR improves Microsoft SharePoint by: adding a digital tag to track all file activity on the Microsoft SharePoint server(s); using the digital tag to create specific rules for determining who can access and manipulate files on the Microsoft SharePoint server(s); allowing the organization to manage the files through contextually-based groups or classifications; extending the Microsoft SharePoint Workflow Engine for programming assurance into business processes which run document usage.

In addition, InDorse Discover, InDorse Tag and InDorse Protect enable companies to organize sensitive information and assure the document usage is in accordance with a company's compliance policies. The software sits on top of file servers, such as Microsoft's Windows File Sharing, Microsoft SharePoint, UNIX or Novell, to assess files in the following manner: classify the documents into clusters based on file content, business relevance and usage patterns; classify clustered information for viewing and printing privileges; tag documents to follow the trail; secure and report on document lifecycles based on usage patterns that align to the native file format's security; and protect consumer privacy and meet government and industry regulations such as PCI, HIPAA, Basel II, GBLA, SOX and SB-1386.
